Noted Theologian Praises Bible Institute's Course Designers

TUCSON, AZ: A distinguished theologian recently praised course designers from Genesis Bible Institute for their creation of a distance learning course on biblical exegesis. The course was designed by qualified inmates with the assistance of Genesis staff.

Dr. Michael Gorman, Professor and Department Chair of Biblical and Theological Studies at St. Mary's Seminary and University, Baltimore, MD, commended the course designers for their development of a course that utilizes his book, *Elements of Biblical Exegesis*, as the primary text (exegesis deals with critically examining a biblical text to interpret its original meaning).

"Those who have prepared this course have done an amazing job of laying out the process of exegesis in understandable language and have designed excellent questions and exercises to help [students] become insightful interpreters of Scripture," said Gorman.

The exegesis course is one of many courses offered through Genesis Bible Institute that includes collaboration with inmates.

"We have a unique story in that our courses have been developed with the input of incarcerated persons and are relevant to their needs, concerns, challenges, and goals," said David Johnson, the Chairman of the Board for Genesis College and Seminary. "God is changing lives in the prison system through Genesis, using volunteers and recognized leaders throughout the country to do so,



as well as repentant inmates who are surrendered to Christ."

Genesis Bible Institute is the prison ministry arm of Genesis College and Seminary, a 501(c)3 formed in 2018 by an interdenominational team of pastors, teachers, professors, administrators, and inmates. The oversight team consists of well-known leaders in Arizona, including Richard Luebke, Board Chairman for Pima Medical Institute, John DelHousaye, Professor of Biblical Studies at Arizona Christian University, and Retired Colonel Dick Tolliver, a Tuskegee Airmen Protégé.
