

Syllabus BIB 101: Fundamentals of the Faith Genesis Bible Institute

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Welcome to BIB 101: Fundamentals of the Faith! This course lays the basic foundation for building a life in Christ. A required course for every student, our goal is to make sure you clearly understand the basic tenets of Christianity.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon completion of this course you will be able to:

- Identify the many certainties about your relationship with God, including the promises that you are saved, filled with the Holy Spirit, forgiven, have eternal life, and have a new identity in Christ;
- Describe the keys to spiritual growth, which include reading and applying God's Word, resisting temptation, persevering through trials, prayer and spending time with other believers;
- Discuss and apply the teachings in the Gospel of John;
- Quote two Bible verses from memory: John 3:16 and John 14:6.

ASSIGNMENTS and GRADING

- *Study Guide Answers* (worth 30 points / 30% of grade). As you read the Study Guide: Twenty Foundational Truths, you will be prompted to answer questions based upon the content. There are a total of 30 questions.
- Assignment 1: Knowing God (worth 20 points / 20% of grade) You will read Pritchard's An Anchor for the Soul and complete 40 fill-in-the-blank statements. Each statement is worth 0.5 points.
- Assignment 2: Reflection on the Gospel of John (worth 30 points / 30% of grade) The purpose of the reflection paper is to provide a summary of what you have read and how it has impacted your life. In Part 1 of the reflection paper, you will write a short summary (75-100 words) of each chapter. In Part 2 you will discuss what God reveals to you about himself and how it applies to your life. Part 2 must be a minimum of 500 words.



• *Final Exam* (worth 20 points / 20% of grade). Final Exam consists of True/False and Multiple Choice questions. The Final Exam will help measure your understanding of course concepts.
