

Syllabus HIS 290: History of the Early Church Genesis Bible Institute

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Millions of Christians gather each week to worship Jesus Christ. How did the Christian church grow from a small band of followers into a dominant worldwide presence? This course examines the beginning of the church and its growth from Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and to the ends of the earth (Acts 1:8). This course also emphasizes the expansion of the church through the work of the Holy Spirit and those who laid down their lives for Christ.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon completion of this course, you will be able to:

- Explain the gospel message;
- Describe Paul's conversion and testimony;
- Compare Paul's mission/ministry to Jesus';
- Describe and compare the early martyrdoms found in Acts;
- Explain how the Holy Spirit empowered the apostles and the church;
- Summarize the conflicts between Jewish authorities and the early church;
- Make connections between Paul's epistles and events in Acts;
- Summarize Paul's strategies/arguments in defense of Jesus and the gospel;
- Analyze major events in Acts that served to grow the church and the opposition to it;
- Witness to skeptics and unbelievers;
- Evaluate the persecution of the apostles and describe its effect on you personally;
- Quote two Bible verses from memory: Acts 1:8 and Acts 4:12.

ASSIGNMENTS AND GRADING

- Study Guide Answers (worth 60 points/60% of grade)
 The Study Guide consists of 6 units. You will examine issues related to the early church and reply to 10 questions in each unit for a total of 60 short-answer responses. Each answer is worth one point.
- Assignment 1: A Glimpse of the Martyrs (worth 10 points/10% of grade)
 Upon reading the excerpt from Foxe's Book of Martyrs, you will consider the lives of ten apostles and create a chart that describes the people group/country to whom each apostle preached and how each was martyred.
- Assignment 2: The Persecuted Apostles (worth 20 points/20% of grade)
 Using Foxe's Book of Martyrs (pp. 1-18) as your source, you will write a 5-paragraph essay that evaluates the persecution of the Apostles and describes its effect on you personally. There is no word length required for this paper.
- Final Exam (worth 10 points/10% of grade)
 You will be tested on the two verses you memorized in this course: Acts 1:8 and Acts 4:12.
