CHL 267: Biblical Leadership – Pastoral Epistles Genesis Bible Institute

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is an examination of the Pastoral Epistles as a textbook guide to biblical leadership. It presents an overview of the calling, character, and commission necessary for leaders to be effective in their church and ministry to the community, giving special attention to the qualifications of elders/pastors and their distinctive role. Drawn from Paul's exhortation to Timothy and Titus, this course will lay groundwork instruction for leaders to guide, guard, and grow the church of God.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon completion of this course, you will be able to:

- Describe the character traits and skills that qualify biblical leaders, distinguishing between differing roles;
- Compare/contrast what constitutes healthy/dangerous teaching and who qualifies as able to teach;
- Identify examples of leadership in the earthly ministry of the Lord Jesus;
- Apply Paul's teaching to your practical leadership experience;
- Cite from memory 2 Timothy 2:15 and 2 Timothy 3:16-17.

REQUIRED READING

- 1 and 2 Timothy and Titus: you may use the Bible translation of your choice, but all quotes and references in the course will be from the ESV. You will be required to read through all three epistles for each of the six units, thus providing a thorough grasp of Paul's instruction. You will memorize 2 Timothy 2:15 and 3:16-17.
