

Syllabus CHM 285: Introduction to Christian Ministry Genesis Bible Institute

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is a study of the underlying and foundational components necessary for effective ministry within the local church context. Special attention is given to the Kingdom impact church members can make when they come together as a team to fulfill God's purpose. Students explore their place in Christian ministry, discovering how their spiritual gifts inform their calling. Students also learn how to recruit and train potential leaders and develop them to become servant leaders.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon completion of this course, you will be able to:

- Create a plan to develop new leaders utilizing fractal design;
- Analyze personal tendencies to determine your likely spiritual gifts;
- Demonstrate an understanding of the necessary steps to design and launch a ministry;
- Determine what type of leader you are;
- Contrast secure leaders with insecure leaders;
- Explain and demonstrate fractal design in leadership hierarchy;
- Explain the elements of a "healthy" ministry team;
- Identify and articulate your God-given dream;
- Quote from memory Ephesians 4:11-12 and 2 Timothy 2:5.
