

Syllabus CHM 375: Lifestyle of Worship Genesis Bible Institute

COURSE DESCRIPTION

It is our moral imperative to worship God. But we cannot worship him in just any manner; he accepts only the worship that he himself decreed.

This course is an introduction to worship as a way of life. It will inspire you to "continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God" (Hebrews 13:5) so that your life becomes an unending song of worship.

- Describe what true worship looks like;
- Analyze the effects of improper worship in a church body;

- Explain the three types of false worship discussed by Tozer;
- Quote two bible verses from memory: John 4:23, Romans 12:1.

ASSIGNMENTS AND GRADING

- Study Guide Answers (worth 45 points / 45% of grade)
 The Study Guide consists of six units. You will answer a total of 60 fill-in-the-blank questions (10 questions per unit), which address the worship found in many of today's churches. You will also describe in each unit how Tozer's teaching applies to your life and ministry.
- Assignment 1: Create-A-Quiz (worth 15 points / 15% of grade)
 For this assignment you will create a 15-question quiz covering the book
 The Air I Breathe by Louie Giglio. The quiz will consist of 5 True or False questions, 5
 Multiple-choice questions, and 5 Fill-in-the-blank questions, plus an Answer Key.



- Assignment 2: Analyze A Church's Corporate Worship Service (worth 15 points / 15% of grade)
 - In this assignment you will attend (or recall) a service from a church body and analyze that service through the lens of true worship. You will then write four paragraphs: The first paragraph will describe the service you are analyzing. The second will show the areas of the service you felt aligned with what you have learned. The third will outline the areas you felt the service could have been improved. The fourth will be the recommendations you would give to the leadership. Each paragraph should be 100 words or fewer.
- Final Exam (worth 25 points / 25% of grade)
 The Final Exam, which consists of 20 multiple choice questions and scripture memorization, will measure your knowledge of course concepts.
