

Syllabus CHL 440: Parenting Potential Genesis Bible Institute

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course examines 14 gospel principles that cultivate effective parenting. Special emphasis is given to the life-giving power of grace to raise godly children. Students will learn how to encourage, call and train their children to willingly and joyfully live as disciples of Christ Jesus.

- Recite from memory Matthew 28:18-20;
- Recognize deficiencies in parenting that must be overcome;
- Identify misused parental powers;
- Summarize 14 Gospel Principles for Parenting;
- Identify various methods of gospel-based discipline;
- Apply the 14 Gospel Principles for Parenting to different situations;
- Defend the use of gospel parenting principles in your life;
- Create a 5-part parenting action plan for adopting the 14 Gospel Principles for Parenting;
- Compose a 14-statement manifesto outlining your family's belief.

ASSIGNMENTS AND GRADING

- Study Guide Answers (60 points / 60% of grade)
 The Study Guide contains 6 units. You will examine 14 gospel principles and apply them to your life. Each unit consists of 20 questions and each question is worth 0.5 points.
- Assignment 1: A Family Manifesto (15 points / 15% of grade)
 You will create a 14-statement manifesto that outlines your family's beliefs. Each statement will be grounded in Scripture and all of Tripp's 14 gospel principles will be represented.



- Assignment 2: Parenting Action Plan (15 points / 15% of grade)
 You will create a 5-part action plan to adopt one of Paul Tripp's 14 gospel principles for parenting. You will write a 100-word description of the principle and why it resonates with you. You will then write five (50-100 words) paragraphs explaining a different way in which you might implement your chosen gospel principle into your parenting.
- Final Exam: (10 points / 10% of grade)
 The final exam consists of 14 matching questions and three Bible verses. To review for the final exam, have a working knowledge of the 14 gospel principles and what each principle entails.
