

# Syllabus THE 380: Spirit-Empowered Living Genesis Bible Institute

### COURSE DESCRIPTION

Many Christians neglect the Holy Spirit and his role in their lives. What they do not understand is that without him, they operate in their own strength, failing to live a supernatural life. The same Holy Spirit that was available to Jesus is available to us. The question is, why do we fail to seek the Holy Spirit and experience more of him in our lives?

This course is an introduction to living a Spirit-filled life. You will learn how to maintain emotional health, redeem relationships, be perfected through suffering, and forgive others as you discover how to live your life through the presence and power of the Holy Spirit.

Upon completion of this course you will be able to:

- Discuss the Holy Spirit's role in the life of a believer;
- Evaluate an area of your life in which you need the Holy Spirit to help you wholeheartedly love God and others;
- Explain how your greatest ministry comes from your deepest pain;
- Discuss how even good and godly desires can lead to death;
- Describe what constitutes spiritual maturity;
- Evaluate your relationship with others to determine the health of those relationships;
- Experience inner healing through the power of the Holy Spirit by taking steps to forgive others and seek forgiveness;
- Discuss how to become emotionally healthy through the power of the Holy Spirit;
- Quote John 7:37-38 from memory.

## ASSIGNMENTS and GRADING
