Genesis Bible Institute to Offer Online Courses to Inmates

Tucson, AZ: Genesis Bible Institute is pleased to announce that it signed a contract with Edovo, the primary provider of online instruction to inmates across the country. Edovo, which is headquartered in Chicago, IL, is an online learning app that appears on the prison-issued tablets of more than 600,000 inmates in every state but Oregon.

Edovo provides education, job skills, spirituality and reentry programs at no cost to "justice-impacted" individuals. "We can't be more pleased with this new development," said David Johnson, the Chairman of the Board for Genesis College and Seminary. "We currently provide Bible courses to inmates in eight states by mailing them coursework, but now inmates in 49 states will be able to access our tuition-free courses right on their tablets." The contract with Edovo was signed on August 9, 2024, and Genesis Bible Institute is now beginning the process of uploading its rehabilitation, reentry, and Bible courses. "All of our material promotes spiritual and moral rehabilitation, and we are excited to extend our reach in helping inmates discover life transformation through God's Word and the power of the gospel."

Genesis Bible Institute is the prison ministry of Genesis College and Seminary. The college is a 501(c)3 formed in 2018 by an interdenominational team of pastors, teachers, professors, administrators, and inmates.
